



**CITY COUNCIL NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
TUESDAY, February 23, 2021 – 7:00 PM**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that pursuant to Chapter 35A.63.220 of the Revised Code of Washington, the Covington City Council will hold a public hearing for consideration of a six-month extension of the temporary moratorium on the creation, development, or expansion of self-service storage facilities, which includes, without limitation, acceptance, processing, and approval of building permit applications or land use applications for self-service storage facilities located, or proposed to be located, within the mixed commercial and general commercial zones. The public hearing will take place at the city council's regular meeting on **Tuesday, February 23, 2021 at 7:00 p.m.** The city council meeting will be held telephonically and virtually to comply with state executive and legislative actions that indefinitely prohibit public agencies from meeting in person. This prohibition will remain in effect until the termination of the COVID-19 state of emergency, or until rescinded by gubernatorial or legislative action.
