# Covington & King County Fall Recycling Collection Event

September 11, 2021 - 9am to 3pm - Kentwood High School



## Only the Following Items Will be Accepted.....



- **TIRES:** Limit 6 passenger tires per vehicle (18 inches and below) free of charge. \$1.50 for extra tires off rim. \$3.00 for all passenger tires on rims. \$9 charged for each large truck tire and \$18 charged for each truck tire on rim (*cash only*). No oversized tires accepted.
  - **LEAD ACID BATTERIES:** Car, truck, marine, motorcycle, and sealed lead acid batteries accepted.
  - **ALKALINE BATTERIES:** AAAA, AAA, AA, A, B, C, and D cell alkaline batteries. No rechargeable, cellphone, lithium, or nickel-cadmium batteries accepted.
  - **NEW ITEM - This is a pilot project. ELECTRONIC/COMPUTER EQUIPMENT:** DVD players, VCRs, stereo equipment, printers, copiers, fax machines, scanners, and cellular phones (**remove personal information**). Computers and computer monitors, mouse, keyboards, tablet computers, and e-readers (**no charge**).
  - **NEW ITEM - This is a pilot project. TELEVISION SETS:** TV sets encased in plastic, wood console, sets encased in wood, and big screen TVs accepted (**no charge**).
  - **CONFIDENTIAL DOCUMENT SHREDDING:** Shredding and recycling of confidential paper materials. Limit 4 file-size boxes. No exceptions.
  - **CARDBOARD:** Please flatten. No wax coated cardboard.
  - **PORCELAIN TOILETS AND SINKS:** \$15 charge (*cash only*). Toilet seats, hardware, and base wax rings must be removed.
  - **PROPANE TANKS:** Residential tanks only. \$5 charge (*cash only*).
  - **BULKY WOOD:** Includes tree branches (minimum 6 inches in diameter), logs, clean wood, plywood, pallets, and other untreated and unpainted wood. **No peg board, particle or press board. No leaves, grass, small branches, sod, or brush. Please lay a tarp under material for ease of removal.**
  - **APPLIANCES AND SCRAP METAL:** Auto parts, engines and gas lawnmowers (**drained of oil and gasoline**), appliances, metal lawn chairs, stoves, microwaves, washers & dryers, dishwashers, barbecues, iron, steel, aluminum, brass, copper, and other ferrous and nonferrous metals. **\$5 will be charged for each water heater that still has insulation coating (cash only).** Metals that are insulated, rubber or oil coated, previously or currently contain **gas, oil, chemicals, paint, or hazardous materials** will not be accepted. Light fixture ballasts, and sealed drums will not be accepted.
  - **REFRIGERATORS/FREEZERS:** \$30 (*cash only*) will be charged for each refrigerator or freezer. \$35 (*cash only*) will be charged for each household air conditioner. **Please be prepared to pay at event entrance.**
  - **MATTRESSES/BOX SPRINGS:** Mattresses and box springs, any size. **\$15 per mattress (cash only) and \$15 per box spring (cash only).**
- Vendor reserves the right to refuse any item it cannot recycle. No furniture or frames. No wet or soiled items.

**Please provide exact change for user fees.**

**PLEASE NOTE: HOUSEHOLD GOODS AND CLOTHING will not be accepted. This material can be self hauled to donation locations in the local area. CALL FIRST TO CONFIRM LOCATIONS ARE OPEN AND ACCEPTING MATERIAL.**

**PLEASE ALSO NOTE: STYROFOAM BLOCKS AND PACKING PEANUTS will not be accepted. This material can be self hauled to StyroRecycle located at 23418 68th Ave S, Kent, WA - (253) 838-9555. Check out <http://www.styrorecycle.com>.**



## These household wastes:

- No construction/demolition debris
- No garbage
- No furniture
- No plastic toys, hoses, etc.
- No window glass

## These hazardous wastes:

- NO MOTOR OIL, FILTERS, AND ANTIFREEZE
- No paint of any kind
- No solvents or thinners
- No pesticides/herbicides
- No household chemicals
- No cleaning products
- No fluorescent lights

**Household hazardous wastes (but not latex paint) can be taken to the Auburn Wastemobile at the Outlet Collection Mall (next to Nordstrom Rack) every Saturday and Sunday from 10 am to 5 pm (except major holidays). Also the roving Wastemobile will visit Covington on September 10, 11, and 12, 2021. Hours are from 10 am to 5 pm. Location: Puget Sound Fire Station #75 - 15635 272nd St, Kent, WA, 98042. Volume restrictions apply. Please segregate motor oil from all other fluids.**

CALL FIRST TO CONFIRM LOCATIONS ARE OPEN AND HOURS. Note - drop off locations and conditions may change. Quantities accepted may be limited. Please also note that computer peripherals such as keyboards, mice, and printers are not included in this program but will be accepted at the City Recycling Collection Events. **Beware, it is always a good idea to delete or remove all personal information from any item you are recycling - better safe than sorry.**
